



Working Tile by Max Lamb

He designed a set of modular, three-dimensional tiles that can create countless shapes, with the resulting objects performingas vases, sofas, tables, benches or partition walls. He used typical clays with characteristic earthy attributes, and special glazes with ambiguous colours harkening to classic Japanese tiles. His production method is pressure moulding which allows highly precise threedimensionalshapes and patterns.
