

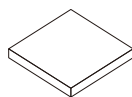
Working Tile by Max Lamb

In this project, Max showcases what makes Tajimi a unique manufacturing location and what TCT hopes to achieve. He designed a set of modular, three-dimensional tiles that can create countless shapes, with the resulting objects performing as vases, sofas, tables, benches or partition walls. He used typical clays with characteristic earthy attributes, and special glazes with ambiguous colours harkening to classic Japanese tiles. His production method is pressure moulding which allows highly precise three-dimensional shapes and patterns.



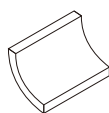

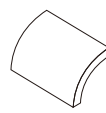

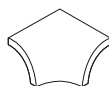
